Learning Plan January 2025 - June 2025

Learning Focus: Beginner Chinese

Thursday 15:30-17:00 beginner 启蒙

Sunday 10:00-11:30 higher beginner 初级

This course is designed for children who want to develop their interest in Chinese and build a solid foundation in the language. Early Chinese education emphasizes systematic learning of Pinyin, early reading, and writing.

As part of a long-term learning plan, beginners concentrate on developing the following foundational skills:

Pinyin, 23 initials, 24 finals, 16 whole syllables, a total of 63 Early Reading Skills

Early Writing Skills - Pinyin Writing, Chinese Character Writing

The course systematically teaches Pinyin using the Chinese Pinyin course adopted by both domestic and

international schools in China. Progress is achieved through regular lessons, with students attending 1.5-hour sessions once a week. Active participation and communication in Chinese with classmates and teachers are essential throughout the course.

In Chinese schools, children typically dedicate 40 minutes every day to this course, completing most beginner-level Chinese studies within six months.

We expect all Fanfan Chinese course participants to:

- Listen and participate actively
- Follow instructions
- Be polite, respectful, and considerate of others
- Put in their best effort, even when the work is challenging!

Learning Focus: Intermediate Chinese

The Intermediate course is designed for children who want to improve their overall Chinese

comprehension and strengthen their language skills.

It is intended for children who can already speak Chinese, communicate confidently, and have mastered Pinyin but need to consolidate spelling, improve literacy, and expand their reading and writing abilities.

This course will also incorporate some aspects of textbook learning.

As part of a long-term learning plan, Intermediate Chinese focuses on the following areas:

- recognizing Chinese characters
- expanding vocabulary
- improving listening and reading comprehension
- forming words and sentences
- writing sentences and short essays

The core of the program is the systematic teaching of Chinese through a curriculum widely used in domestic and international Chinese schools. The curriculum is gradually built up through months of consistent study. To achieve progress, students must commit to the program for the long term, attending

one 1.5-hour class per week. Throughout the course, students are expected to communicate with their classmates and teachers exclusively in Chinese.

In Chinese schools, children typically study this program in targeted ability groups for about 40 minutes per day, completing most of their intermediate Chinese learning within six months.

Learning Focus: Advanced Chinese

Monday: 15:30-17:00 (Primary School Chinese 4, 小学语文 4)

Saturday: 10:30-12:00 (Chinese 8, 华语 8)

Age Group: 9-15 years old

This course is designated for students aged 9-15 who aim to deepen their understanding of the Chinese language, culture, and history. Students will improve their reading, writing, and comprehension skills.

The core of Advanced Chinese learning aligns with that of Chinese primary schools, offering a rich exploration of Chinese literature, culture, and history.

Reading: Explore poetry, ancient texts, classic idioms, historical allusions, and articles on various topics.

Writing: Develop the ability to write essays and express personal opinions and insights.

Reading Comprehension: Answer questions based on reading material and write responses.

Grammar: Learn grammar through formal instruction.

Vocabulary: Expand vocabulary

Students are required to communicate exclusively in Chinese during lessons to maximize their learning experience.
