Intermediate Group - Year 3 and 4 Content

Advanced Group - Year 5 and 6 Content

Age group: 9-11 years

Schedule: Daily 15:00-16:00

Join our fun Holiday Writing and Handwriting Programmes, tailored for English as an Additional Language (EAL) learners in Year 3 and 4 (Intermediate), and Year 5 and 6 (Advanced). Pupils will refine their writing skills while developing and practising legible joined handwriting.

Week 1: Creative Writing & Handwriting Skills

Theme: Snow and Skiing Adventures

In Week 1, pupils will focus on building strong handwriting foundations, learning to join letters neatly and consistently. Creative writing exercises will include fun writing prompts.

Week 1: Creative Writing & Handwriting Skills

Theme: Christmas Tales

pupils will continue refining their handwriting, developing further joining skills. The focus will also be on enhancing written expression, exploring Christmas characters and settings.

Our tutors use a patient and communicative approach that fosters both creativity and technical skill. Each session will feature activities designed to improve handwriting, promote imagination, and increase confidence in written expression.
